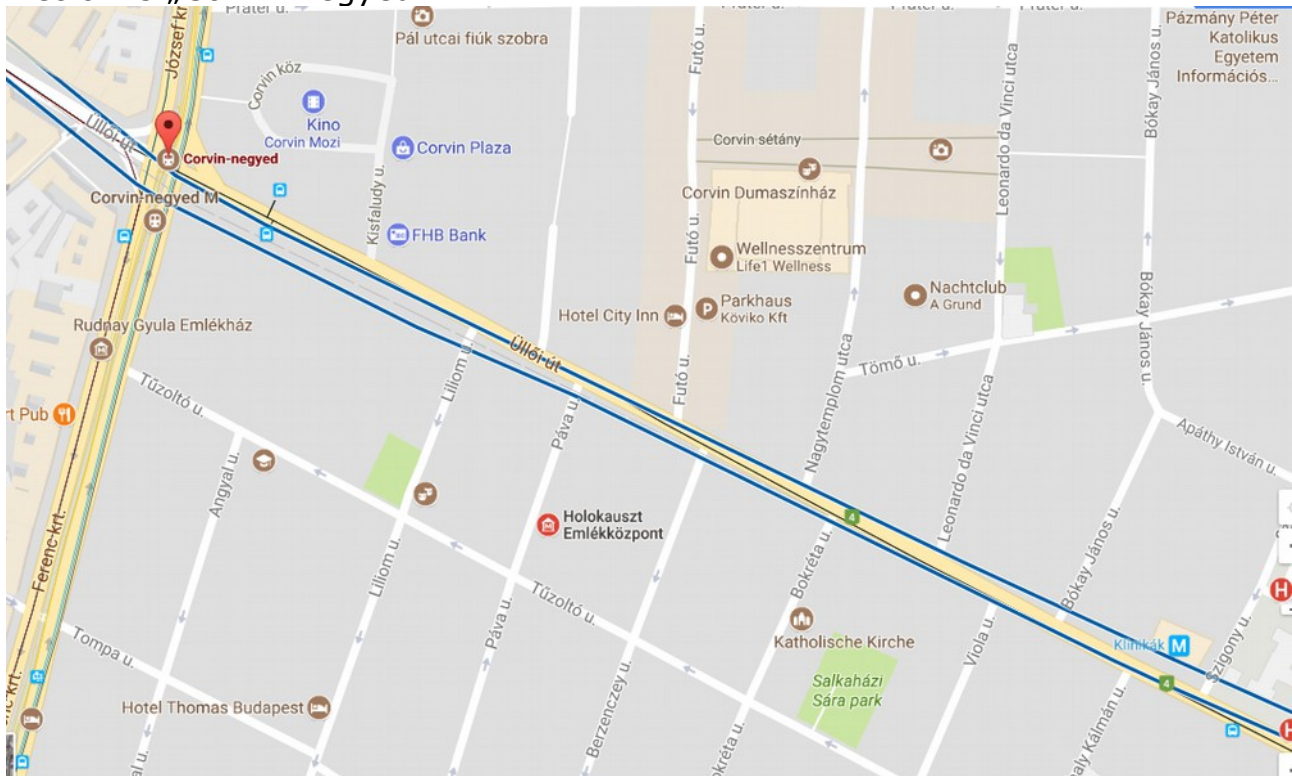

Tickets for Public Transport

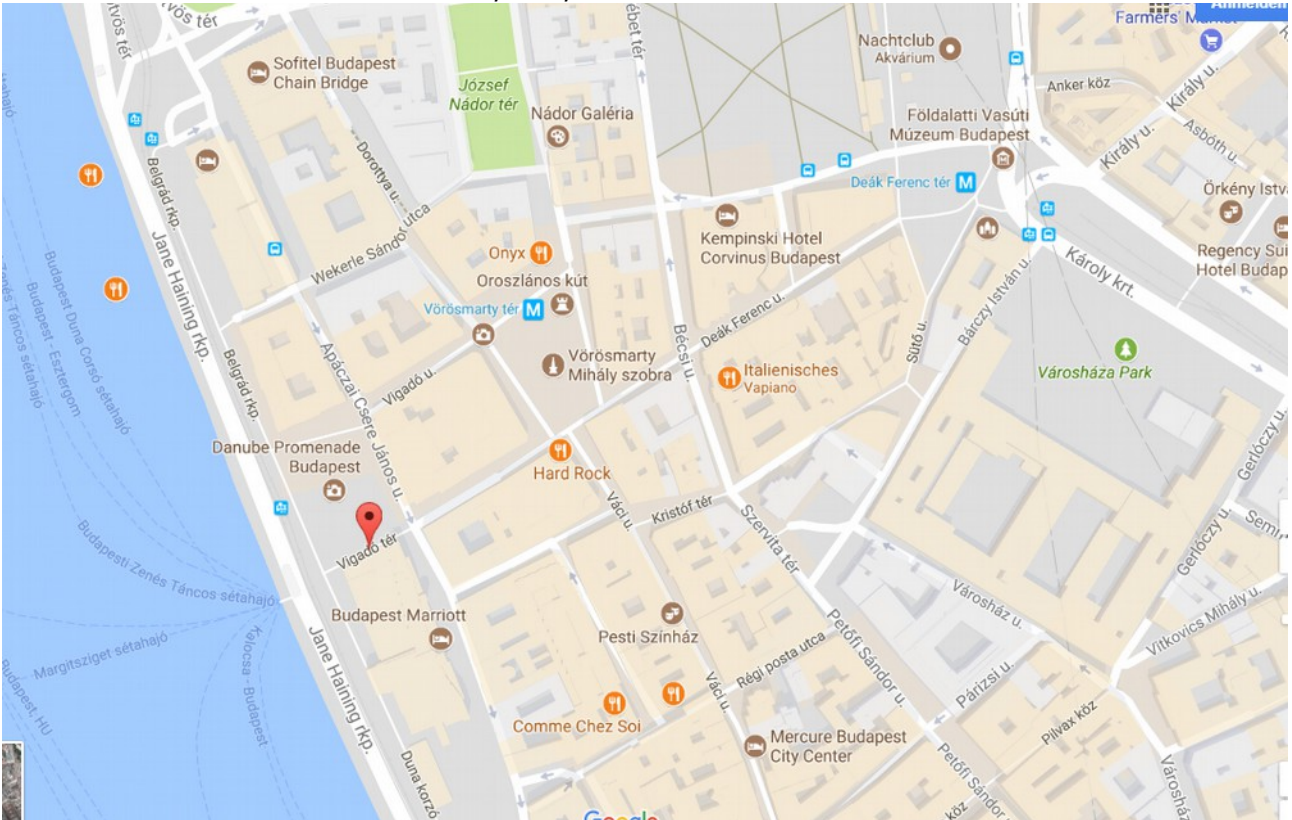
Regular single tickets are valid for only one trip on a single vehicle (350 Forint or 3000 Forint for 10 pieces coupon book).

In the metro line one ticket is enough to use the whole system with changes. Another valid option is a 72 hour ticket for 4150 HUF. You can buy all types at: automats, the offices of the local public transport company (BKK) at major traffic junctions and metro stations. Single tickets are sold at newspaper shops, relays, certain tobacco shops („T 18”) as well.

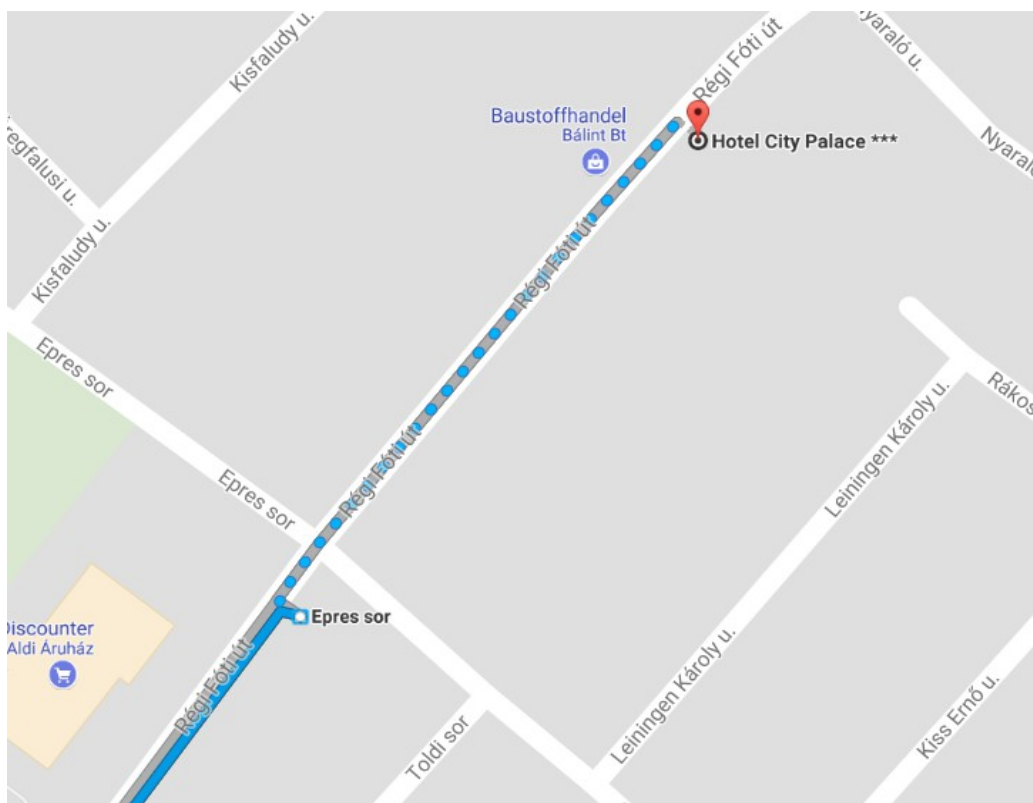

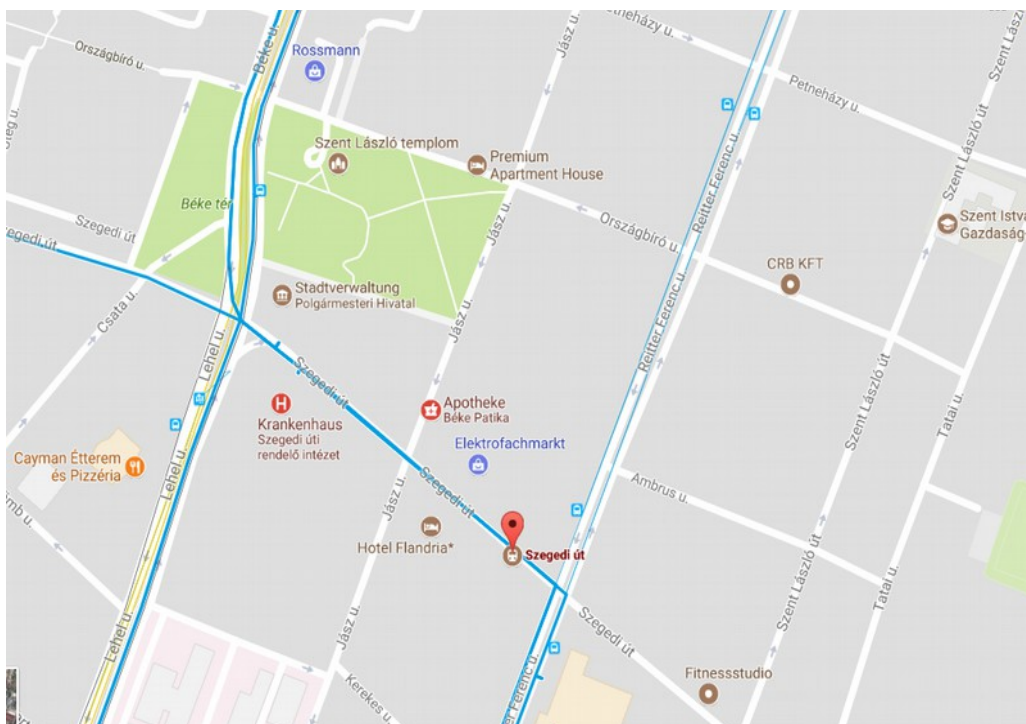
